

# Safe In Austin Rescue Ranch

Safe In Austin is a 501(c)3 nonprofit sanctuary dedicated to rescuing, rehabilitating, and caring for animals that have been abused, abandoned, or have special needs. They show their rescues a new way of life by sharing their unique stories, and introducing them to children with similar backgrounds to heal alongside the animals.

In addition to making a donation, volunteer to help out Safe In Austin by applying to volunteer:

- Group Volunteering
  - **Who:** Anyone over 8 is welcome to volunteer.
  - **What:** Experience the work it takes to run a nonprofit sanctuary with over 170 animal residents of over a dozen different species, and learn valuable skills related to animal health behavior and care – all while bonding with many different animals.
  - **When:** usually 10am – 12pm, though shift details can only be determined after submitting a volunteer application at the link above.
  - **Where:** at the ranch – 14601 Honeycomb Dr. Leander, TX 78641
  - **Requirements:** Volunteers must be registered in advance of the session, and have signed the waiver. They must also bring their own water and dress accordingly (including work gloves, closed-toe shoes, and clothes you're willing to get muddy in). Finally, they must also be able to lift 30 pounds and do general physical work.
  - **Recommended Group Size:** Anywhere from a small group of just a few people, all the way up to 40 people.
